Objective

This code of conduct manual is designed with an aim to provide a precise definition of the minimal standards of personal conduct that the College expects from all its students & faculty. It represents a benchmark of expectations regarding students, and faculty, and defines the precincts within which a rewarding and mutually supportive learning environment can be created.

It is based on the assumption that most students can uphold these statements of conduct, and may endorse them without any problem.

Student code of Conduct

1. Adherence to Policies

- Students are expected to go through the Rules & Regulations book, Code of Integrity, and to the Student Manual, and familiarize themselves with the College policies relevant to them.
- Students must adhere to these policies to the best of their ability, and assist & encourage fellow students to adhere to the policies too.
- If students perceive any problem with the any of the students' rules or expected code of integrity, or related policies, they should mention the same to their counselor.

2. General Code of Conduct/Expected Behavior

Students are expected to maintain College decorum, and to ensure that their behavior is apt and respectful to others, & is supportive to the college objectives. Students are expected not to use the class environment or the online environment to:

- Utter profane or obscene language
- Make derogatory or discriminatory remarks of racist or sexist nature.

- Engage in inappropriate behavior, or make remarks that can be easily perceived as threatening.
- Defame the college or any part of the college thereof.
- Disturb the class or create union against the college, or distract the class in support of any personal, political, religious, or other social agenda.
- Encourage disrespectful environment, or get involved in eve-teasing, or other inapt behavior.
- Indulge in pornography, drugs, or alcohol
