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Chapter 1

Placement Committee (PC)

Introduction:

College puts in its best efforts to provide placement assistance to all the students enrolled in the college, even though it is not a mandatory function of the college.

Despite this, the college conducts Training & Placement Sessions (PTS), distinct from the activities of the Placement Committee (PC), to embark on the student skills honing process from the beginning of the college studies. . The sessions are conducted from second semester to the fifth semester, with a commitment to sharpen student skills for placements and for overall personality development of the students, serving as a complementary activity for the Placement Committee.

The activities of the Placement Committee includes mock interviews, one to one sessions, counseling, training sessions, guest speakers, industry tie-ups, and organizing on and off-campus company interviews, and final placements of the students. The Placement Committee conducts its activities dedicated to final year students, till their placements.

PC Objectives:

- To manage centralized placement activities for all the branches.
- To create consciousness among students about the available career options, and to prepare them as per the market requirements.
- To promote career counselling by organizing guest speakers like senior corporate personnel, and the college alumni, who have gained reasonable experience in their respective fields
- To enter into MoUs and collaborations with industries and corporate of repute for campus recruitment.
- To act as a bridge between students and employers.

- To provide ample opportunities to the students by organizing on and off-campus interviews to achieve high percentage of placements.
- To take feedback from the industry and provide inputs for the current curricula.

PC Committee:

The Placement Committee handles all the aspects of campus placement for the graduating students of the college. The committee is well equipped with facilities to support every stage of the placement process. Arrangements for Pre-Placement talks, Industry tie-ups, Collaborations, Campus Interview Arrangements, Group discussions, and Post-Interview Feedback or Placement Support is all provided by the Placement Committee.
